

2011 Henry M. Thornton SCADA Fellowship Awarded

At the 152nd American Dental Association Annual Session in Las Vegas, Nevada, two students received the Henry M. Thornton SCADA Fellowship Award during the DENTSPLY Student Clinician Research Awards Program.

Dr. Nathan Hawley represented the University of Nevada, Las Vegas in the 2009 American Dental Association/DENTSPLY Student Clinician Research Program. He graduated from dental school in 2010, recently completed a Graduate Craniofacial Biology Research Fellowship, and is currently continuing his studies in specialty training in orthodontics at the University of Kentucky to which this Fellowship will be applied.

This year, in recognition of the number of outstanding applicants requesting support for graduate studies, the SCADA Board decided to award a second Henry M. Thornton / SCADA Fellowship Award.

Our second fellowship award recipient, Dr. Jasdeep Kaur, represented BaBa Jaswant Singh Dental College, Hospital and Research Institute in India and is currently pursuing a PhD in Forensic Odontology Master Program at the Catholic University Leuven in Belgium.

Thirty-five years ago the SCADA Fellowship Fund for graduate study in dentistry began. This Fellowship Fund was named in honor of the late Henry M. Thornton, DENTSPLY's Chairman Emeritus, whose vision created this program. Since 1976, SCADA has awarded \$76,500 in Fellowship grants.
