

Chiang Mai University – Worakanya Buranaphatlhana

Chiang Mai University student Worakanya Buranaphatlhana won first place at Thailand's Research Day hosted in Bangkok on December 16, 2009.

Buranaphatlhana's presentation titled, "Effect of human bite forces and bitten object movement on computer aided photogrammetric bite mark analysis" proved that different degrees of biting forces affect most bite mark parameters except the rotation of central incisal edges and the mesio-distal width of canine. Based on her research, Buranaphatlhana concluded these parameters merit further research.

Buranaphatlhana will represent Chiang Mai University at the annual ADA/DENTSPLY Student Clinician Program in Orlando, FL in October.
