Kaori Kaji, a student at Nihon University of Dentistry, was named the winner at the 2009 Japan Student Clinician Programme hosted in Tokyo, August, 2009.

Kaji's presentation titled, "Development of Easy Debondable Orthodontic Bracket Adhesive by Heating," detailed the process of creating debondable adhesive (EDA) for brackets. Through testing it was discovered that EDA is a good bonding material for clinical use since it does not cause pain and enamel cracks during debonding.

Kaji presented her award winning presentation at the American Dental Association meeting in Honolulu, HI in October 2009.
