University of Mississippi School of Dentistry student, Corey Shook won first place at the school's 2010 Research Day in February. Shook's award winning presentation, "Specific effects of endodontic inflammation on the rat aorta" compared the expression of biomarkers of atherosclerosis within serum and the ascending aorta between female and male rats, following creation of experimental periapical abscesses. Shook conducted his research with Dr. Roger Johnson, professor in the Department of Periodontics.

Shook will present his research at the ADA Annual Session in Orlando in October 2010.
