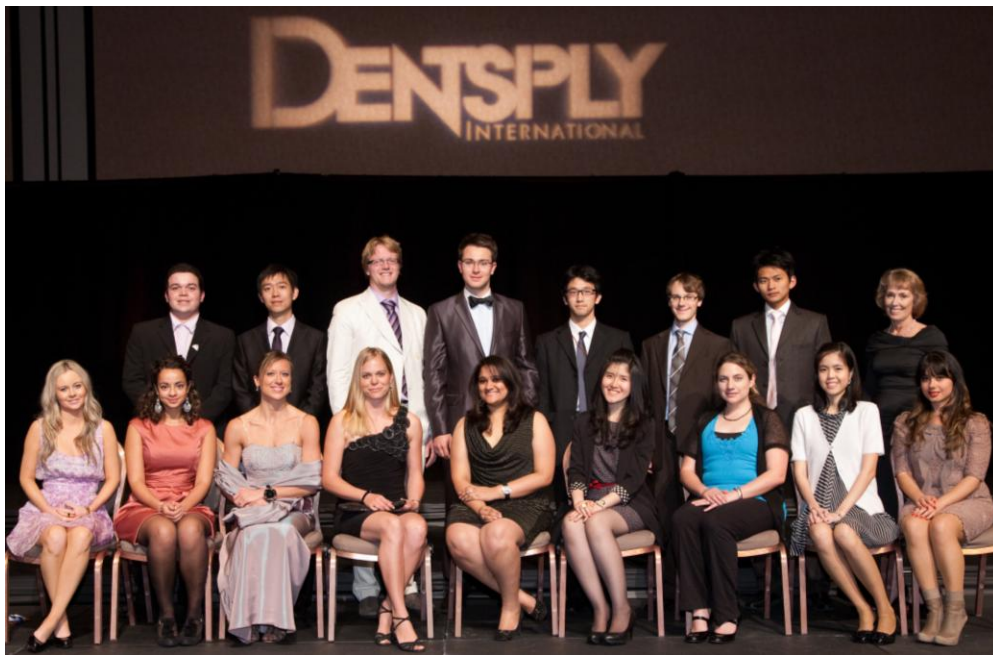


## **DENTSPLY Welcomes the 2011 International Student Clinicians of the American Dental Association**

International award-winning student clinicians from 16 countries were welcomed to the 52<sup>nd</sup> Annual ADA/DENTSPLY Student Clinician Research Award Program on October 9 and 10, 2011 in Las Vegas, Nevada, during the 2011 ADA Annual Session.

This group of extraordinary students presented the results of their clinical, basic science or public health research presentations in their respective countries, winning first prize and an expense-paid trip to the 2011 ADA/DENTSPLY Student Clinician Research Award Program. The 17 dental schools represented by students include University of Queensland, University Center Cismac, Université de Montréal, Sichuan University, Oulu University, University of Lyon, University of Freiburg, University of Bochum, Bharati Vidyapeeth Universit - Pune, University of Trisakti, Hiroshima University, University of the Pretoria, Yonsei University, Koahsiung Medical University, Chulalongkorn University, Selcuk University, and Leeds University.

The students who presented research at their national research program become members of SCADA (Student Clinicians of the American Dental Association), an alumni association designed by and for former student clinicians. Members of SCADA serve as judges for future Student Clinician Research Programs held in conjunction with the ADA Annual Session and help mentor students. In addition to the student awards, SCADA grants fellowship
