



Henry M. Thornton / SCADA Fellowship Award

Award Guidelines

Purpose: The purpose of the Henry M. Thornton / SCADA Fellowship Award is to provide financial support to SCADA Alumni who are pursuing advanced dental education beyond his/her DMD or DDS degree and who are contemplating a career in academic dentistry or dental research.

Focus: SCADA Alumni who are enrolled in an advanced dental education or specialty training program and demonstrate a sincere interest in pursuing a career in dental academia and/or dental research.

Award Description: The award recipient will receive up to **\$3,500 (or equivalent currency)** to defray the cost of education. The funds will be paid directly to the residency program in which the recipient is enrolled.

Eligibility: Candidates must be SCADA alumni, be in good academic standing, and currently enrolled in an eligible academic program. An “eligible program” means a program at a US public, nonprofit or privately owned college or university accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation, or an equivalent agency for programs outside the US.

Application Requirements: Applicants must submit the following materials via the online application and/or email as described in the application.

- Curriculum vitae (Limit to 2 pages).
- Personal Statement (no more than 500 words) describing why you are pursuing advanced training and your interest in pursuing a career in academic dentistry and/or dental research.
- Two letters of support, one of which must be from the applicant's program director.

Application Deadline: Applications must be received by **11:59 p.m. ET on Wednesday, January 31, 2024**. Incomplete application materials will not be considered. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that materials including letters of recommendation are received by the deadline.
